

Call for visiting professors

We are currently seeking for visiting professor (full-time professor at other foreign HE institution) to deliver classes on **European Economic Development**, for Master Degree Students at the Faculty of Management and Economics, Gdańsk University of Technology (Poland).

The course is scheduled for the summer Semester 2019 and combines 15 hours of lectures and 15 hours of computer laboratories (for 3 groups of students), a total of 60 hours of classes to be delivered.

European Economic Development: Main aim of the course is to transfer knowledge concerning economic development process of contemporary economies and practical ability to conduct empirical analysis with the use of real data.
