Description of Content:

I. Traditional Grammar of English: Historical background, The Grammar System: the parts of speech, Subject and Predicate, Verbs, Form and function, Verbals, Word Groups: Phrases, Word Groups: Clauses, The Sentence, Connectives, The Survival of traditional grammar in contemporary linguistics.

II. Comparative Linguistics and American Structural Grammar: Historical background, The Grammar system, Level I: Phonology, Level II: Morphology, Level III: Syntax, The study of structural linguistics in contemporary linguistics: its implications for the study of syntax, semantics and pragmatics.

Assessment Method:

One exam paper combined with one essay to be handed in after each block of topics (two essays maximum in total).

Teaching language:

All teaching support, materials, seminar papers, essays and exams will be in English, both for exchange (foreign) and Spanish students.
