The Spanish National Social Security System guarantees access to healthcare and medication for people insured by the system and their dependants at the following two levels:

Healthcare servicesEn Andalucía, la estructura administrativa y de gestión de apoyo al Sistema Nacional de la Seguridad Social se denomina [*Servicio Andaluz de Salud \(SAS\)*](#), cuya sede central está en Sevilla.

In Andalusia, the administrative body managing the National Social Security System is called the [*Andalusian Health Service \(SAS\)*](#), which is based in Seville.

The online platform [*SAS ClicSalud+*](#) is a useful tool that allows you to make an appointment with your general practitioner, complete various administrative procedures and consult your medical history. The SAS operates a series of secondary care facilities, which include:

Researchers who do not meet the requirements for coverage by the Social Security System and need [*private insurance*](#) may be referred to [*Clínica Cristo Rey*](#) (Jaén) or [*Liclinic*](#) (Linares). It is important to bear in mind that some insurance companies impose a qualifying period so you cannot use their services immediately.
