Firstly, we highly recommend visiting the Jobs & Funding section on the [EURAXESS portal](#). You can search for employment opportunities on the portal using the following filters: area of interest, research experience, country and funding programme. The roll-down menu for 'country' allows you to select countries outside Europe, including Australia, the USA, Brazil, Jordan and India.

A second option for searching for academic posts in research and teaching all over the world is the portal [ProfessorPositions.com](#), which features employment opportunities in the following regions: Oceania, Europe, Asia, North America, Africa and the Middle East.

Employment opportunities Thirdly, if you wish to stay in Europe, another European Commission initiative is the [EURES \(European Employment Services\) portal](#), which published more than 3,305,000 jobs in July 2021.

According to the website, EURES is a European cooperation network of employment services launched in 1994 and designed to facilitate the free movement of workers [...] despite language barriers, cultural differences, bureaucratic challenges, diverse employment laws and a lack of recognition of educational certificates across Europe
