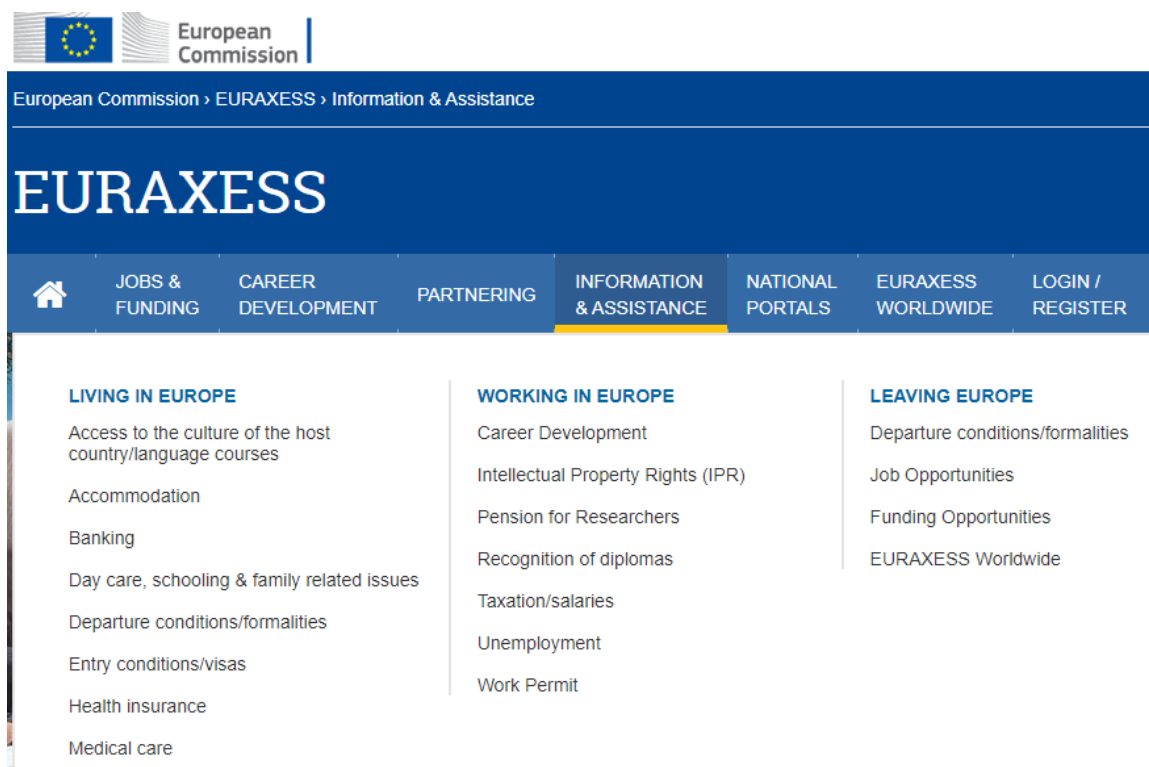


Welcome to the University of Jaén!



Upon arrival to the main campus of the University of Jaén (Las Lagunillas), incoming foreign researchers are encouraged to complete the following **7 steps** for a successful stay with us:

Step 1 Visit the R&I International Projects Office (OFIPI), which is located in B1 Building (Room 025). This is the University of Jaén's EURAXESS Contact Point and, therefore, here you will be able to receive guidance about the following issues:



We kindly suggest carefully reading the **UJA EURAXESS Pre-Arrival Guide for Foreign Researchers** (which is available in both English and Spanish) in order to get familiar with any of these items. Indications on how to both our campuses are also included and campus maps for both locations are available at <https://www.ujaen.es/la-universidad/los-campus> (Free parking onsite).

Apart from when you first arrive, we will be happy to help you at any time during your stay at the University of Jaén (even if your office is located in Linares Campus).

Step 2 Make sure that you meet all the requirements for staying in Spain according to our national regulations. Please, **visit the so-called *Oficina de Extranjería*** right upon your arrival for getting to know all the administrative procedures that you might need to carry out for being able to research in our country for a short or long period of time. The *Oficina de Extranjería* in Jaén is located in Plaza de las Batallas 2. Researchers based in Linares will receive information from its **local police station (C/Hernán Cortés 16)**. Please, make sure that you are also **fully insured** (health/travel/repatriation) during your whole stay with us.

Step 3



Arrange a meeting with your UJA scientific supervisor in his/her office so that you can have an overview of your research work plan at our university. 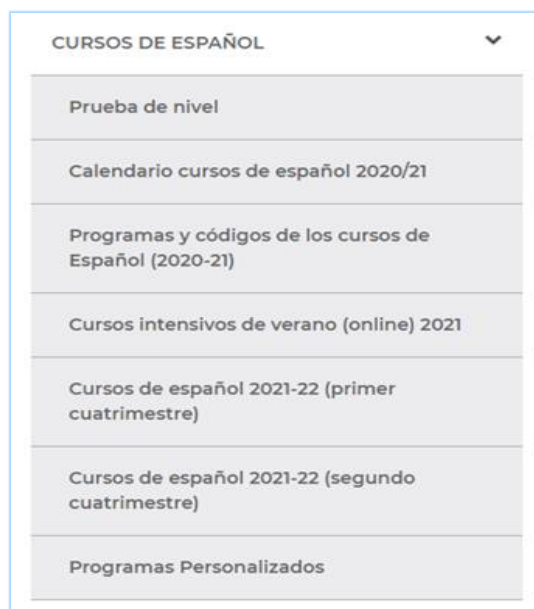
If you need to **open a Spanish bank account** to receive your salary/grant, you will be able to do so at one of **Caja Rural offices** at our Campus (in Buildings D1 and C4):



At any of Caja Rural branches you will also be able to buy a bus card ([Bonobús](#)) for travelling all around the city of Jaén.

Step 6 Although we encourage all incoming researchers to **contact our Language Center** (*Centro de Estudios Avanzados en Lenguas Modernas*, cealm@ujaen.es) before arriving, once at the UJA it is recommended to visit its headquarters as soon as possible to be able to learn Spanish (if needed) thanks to one of their courses.

Apart from learning Spanish language, the UJA CEALM also offers courses in English, French, German, Italian or Portuguese. Lessons are taught at their premises: *Recinto Domingo Savio - Carretera de Madrid s/n. Edificio Alojamientos Universitarios – Entreplanta (23071 Jaén)*.
