He specializes in English travel literature in Spain and in the Mediterranean in general, and in Anglo-Spanish, Anglo-Portuguese, Anglo-Cypriot and Hiberno-Spanish literary relations. He is the author of *Libros de viajes en lengua inglesa por la España del siglo XX* (2003); *English Travel Literature on Cyprus (1878-1960)* and *The Journey to Europe: English Accounts on Cyprus (1960-2004)* (2004 and 2018, with Dr. E. Demetriou) and *Guardias civiles, bandoleros, gitanos, guerrilleros, carabineros, contrabandistas y turistas en la literatura inglesa contemporánea (1844-1994)* (2011), among others. He has also co-edited *Las cosas de Richard Ford* (2010) and edited Marianne Baillie's *Lisbon in the Years 1821, 1822 and 1823 (1824)* (Women's Travel Writings – Iberia, I & II, 2013).
