You can also choose to rent a studio in a private residence or through Airbnb. You will need to manage the booking yourself, but feel free to contact us for suggestions.

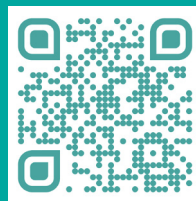
