# **Scholarship description**

# 75 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BACHELOR STUDIES Modality A (50 scholarships)

### • 100% of the tuition fees for the whole chosen Bachelor's degree program<sup>2</sup>.

• A grant of €2,200 (USD 2,400 approx.) per year and candidate.

Health insurance (sickness/hospitalization), repatriation, accidents and third party liability during the period of the scholarship.

• Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students.

# **Modality B (25 scholarships)**

• 100% of the tuition fees for the whole chosen Bachelor's degree program<sup>2</sup>.

· Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students

Students should have a minimum GPA of 8 out of a scale of 10.

# 30 scholarships for Master studies Modality A (20 scholarships)

• 100% of the tuition fees for the whole Master's degree<sup>3</sup>.

- A grant of €3,000 (USD 3,200 approx.) per year and candidate.
- Health insurance (sickness/hospitalization), repatriation, accidents and third party liability during the period of the scholarship.
- Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students.

# **Modality B (10 scholarships)**

• 100% of the tuition fees for the whole Master's degree<sup>3</sup>.

· Free Spanish courses for non-Spanish speaking students

### Students should have a minimum GPA of 8 out of a scale of 10.

<sup>1</sup> 44 scholarships (37 in modality A and 7 for master in modality A) are reserved for students selected under the terms of the agreements with the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Russia, Poland, Brazil, Tunisia and Bulgaria, and 2 places for students who have approved the National High School Exam (ENEM) of Brazil.

<sup>2</sup> It is renewable for a total of four years of undergraduate study and it is subject to approving 90% of the credits annually enrolled.

<sup>3</sup> Master programs usually take one year of full-time study. For 2 years Master programs, scholarship renewal is subject to approving at least 90% of the credits annually enrolled.

# Getting a scholarship for a BA's Degree, How to access to the University of Jaén?

### **Direct Admission for:**

Graduates of the **European Baccalaureate** (British, German, French, or any other EU qualification) or **International Baccalaureate** or equivalent qualification.

Students coming from **educational systems of European Union member states**, as well as from the educational systems of China, Principality of Andorra, Principality of Andorra as well as from the educational systems of China, Principality of Andorra, Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, Liechtenstein and and Liechtenstein.

Students who have completed **partial higher education studies abroad or in Spain** (as long as the University of Jaén has recognized when the University of Jaén has recognized at least 30 ECTS credits).

Students with pre-university studies homologated to Higher Technical Degrees of Vocational Training<sup>4</sup>.

#### Admission process:

1° Make the pre-enrollment in the degree in which it has been beneficiary, in the on-line platform of the Distrito Único. This procedure is mandatory according to the regulations of the University of Jaén and the Single University District of Andalusia.

2° Formalize, according to the established procedures, deadlines and regulations, the corresponding enrollment at the University of Jaén.

## Other criteria for access to the University for:

Graduates of a **Baccalaureate** or equivalent from other educational systems other than those mentioned in the previous section, they must obtain the validation/homologation of the degree by the Spanish Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport of Spain<sup>5</sup>, and comply with the criteria for access to the University of Jaén.

#### Admission process:

1º Meet the criteria for access to the University of Jaén.

2° Make the pre-enrollment in the degree in which you have been beneficiary, in the on-line platform of the Single University District. This procedure is mandatory according to the regulations of the University of Jaén and the Single University District of Andalusia.

3° Formalize, according to the established procedures, deadlines and regulations, the corresponding enrollment at the University of Jaén.
