The RNM-118 group (*Biology of game species and pests*) focuses its research efforts on monitoring and management of wildlife populations, particularly ungulates. Our approach is multidisciplinary, but places special emphasis in the following **research lines**:

- Estimation of abundance
- Biometrical and physiological analysis by means of non-invasive methods
- Health surveillance (epidemiology of parasitosis)
- Genetic characterization of both hosts and parasites

A secondary objective of the RNM-118 group is the study of the ecology of vectors of viruses and other parasites.
